# SOUND SIGNALS



On the Thames there are signals made by the boat's horn to indicate the intention of the boat making the sound.

ONE short blast means  
**I am altering course to STARBOARD**

TWO short blasts mean  
**I am altering course to PORT**

THREE short blasts mean  
**My engines are GOING ASTERN**

FOUR blasts (pause) ONE blast means  
**I am turning right around to STARBOARD**

FOUR blasts (pause) TWO blasts mean  
**I am turning left around to PORT**

ONE LONG & TWO SHORT blasts mean  
**I am UNABLE TO MANOEUVRE**

ONE LONG blast means  
**I am ABOUT TO JOIN THE FAIRWAY** (ie. leave the river bank or mooring)
